August 5, 2010 – Departure airfare for group of 20 | PDX to London/Heathrow Airport  
(flights/times and seats will be determined closer to departure date)

**Itinerary:**

**August 6, 2010** – London/Downtown  
(next day) Arrival into London/Heathrow Airport  
Meet Private Guide and Driver for transfer to St Ermin's Hotel.

Received complimentary London Oyster Card – 20 GBP value. (can be used for London's underground 'Tube', trams & buses)

St. Ermin's Hotel: (2 nights)  
Landmark building with beautiful historic interior close to Houses of Parliament, Westminster Abbey, and Buckingham Palace.  
Bedrooms are modest but represent excellent value for this central location.

Tour with Sonja Grace: All locations are within walking distance  
Westminster Abbey (also see the chapel)  
Buckingham Palace (must see the changing of the guards)  
St. Paul's Cathedral (take tour to catacombs underneath)

**August 8, 2010** – Bath  
Prior arrangements for transfers from Central London to Bath

St Francis Hotel (2 nights)  
Located in the town center, close to all major attractions. Georgian-style building with well-furnished room in the traditional style of varying sizes.

Stonehenge & Bath full-day tour  
Leisurely and at your pace, tour Bath and surrounding areas on your own

**August 10, 2010** – Northern Wales  
Prior arrangements for transfers from Bath into Wales and continue to Northern Wales (3.5 hours from Bath)

Ruthin Castle (2 nights)  
Dating from the 13<sup>th</sup> century, this historic castle dominates the market town of Ruthin, near Chester. Set in private gardens, this castle hotel offers comfortable accommodations in a romantic setting.

Tour with Sonja Grace:  
St Winifred's Well near Flintshire/Holywell

**August 12, 2010** – Scotland  
Prior arrangements for transfers from Northern Wales to Edinburgh, Scotland.

Jurys Inn Edinburgh (3 nights)  
Centrally located right beside the Royal Mile, close to Waverly rail station. Spacious and comfortable rooms.

Edinburgh Castle  
Edinburgh's Underground City

**August 15, 2010** – Dublin, Ireland  
Prior arrangements for transfers from Edinburgh to Dublin, Ireland

Newgrange – (Dublin) Largest earth-chamber in Europe and 5000 years old. It predates the Great Pyramid and Stonehenge (you will not be staying overnight in Dublin)

Family run hotel in the heart of Killarney. Charming décor throughout the property with individually designed rooms furnished with Celtic Deco styling. Has a traditional Irish bar.

Tour with Sonja Grace:

St Bridgett's Well

Round Stone carvings

See medieval friary and ancient yew trees

Take a stroll on the 'Druid Tree walk'

Take a day trip to Kenmare with its own stone circle

Head to the ancient rock shrine of 'Hag of Beare' or 'Old Goddess of this land', which is still visited today by pilgrims.

**August 17, 2010** – Dingle Peninsula

Prior arrangements for transfers from Killarney to Dingle Peninsula

Ballyseede Castle (2 nights)

Ballyseede Castle, Tralee Ireland, is an impressive building and has a history dating back to the 1590's. Wonderfully transformed into a hotel in 1965.

Tour with Sonja Grace:

This is a Gaelic/Irish-speaking region.

This area alone has over 2000 ancient sites, dating from Neolithic through Christian times.

See the 'Bee-hive' huts

8<sup>th</sup> century Gallarus' Oratory, one of the earliest Christian churches found in Ireland.

**August 19, 2010** – Near Shannon Airport

Prior arrangements for transfers from Ballyseede Castle to Dromoland Castle

Dromoland Castle – (1 Night)

The castle, a few miles from Shannon airport, is a magnificent Renaissance structure built in the 16th century, was once the royal seat of the O'Brien clan, direct descendants of Irish King Brian Boru. one of Ireland's finest castle hotels, offers guests the experience of living like landed gentry, surrounded by luxury, beauty and service. Dromoland is one of the few estates tracing its history to native Gaelic Irish families of royal heritage.
